Rules Reminder

- 2 = Triple
- 3 = Double
- 8 or 10 = Single
- 12 = Home Run
- 5 = Walk
- 4,6,7,9,11 = Out

Move your "OUT" token over the baseball spots on the playing board to track the number of outs each inning.

Mark runs scored in each inning in the appropriate inning box.

Total the runs in the "R" box at the end of each game.

Game Play Adjustments:

- Singles advance all runners only one base. No scoring from second base on a single. Doubles advance two, Triples three.
- No double plays (or triple plays).
- No stealing.
- No errors.
- Walks are as normal, advances runners directly in front of them.
- No challenges, no reviews by bigwigs in New York.
